#### HOW CAN I KNOW I AM GOING TO HEAVEN?

**Step #1: Realize God loves you.** "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish, but have eternal life." John 3:16

Step #2: Realize you are separated from God because of sin. "For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God." Romans 3:23 Our solution: People try to earn their way to heaven through good works, religion, morality, etc. "There is a way that seems right to a man, but in the end it leads to death." Proverbs 14:12

God's solution: A relationship with Jesus Christ who died on the Cross and rose from the grave, paying the penalty for our sin. "...For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus." 1 Timothy 2:5, "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God – not by works, so that no one can boast." Ephesians 2:8-9

Step #3: Receive Jesus Christ as personal Savior. "If you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved." Romans 10:9
You may wish to use the sample prayer below. "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." Romans 10:13

## FOUR PARTS TO THE LORD'S SUPPER

I Corinthians 11:17-34

#### I. Part #1 - <u>Self-examination</u> (v. 17-22, 27-34)

- A. Why should we examine ourselves? Because if I don't:
  - 1. I'll be guilty of sin.
  - 2. I'll be judged.
  - 3. I may get sick and even die.
- B. How we should examine ourselves?
  - 1. Spiritually (I John 3:9-10; 5:17)
  - 2. Relationally (Matthew 5:23-24)
  - 3. Financially (I Timothy 6:6-19)
  - 4. Emotionally (Philippians 2:1-5)
  - The Lord's Supper is <u>not</u> necessary for salvation.

"That if you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."

Romans 10:9

ACTION POINT: Is your conscious clean before God and others?

#### II. Part #2 – <u>The bread</u> (v. 23-24)

A. The bread is a symbol of Jesus' body.

"Christ was sacrificed once to take away the sins of many."

Hebrews 9:28

- B. The bread reminds us:
  - 1. Jesus was a <u>real man</u> with a real body.
  - 2. Jesus <u>suffered</u> and died for us. (Mark 14:63-65; 15:15-24)

3. Jesus provided a way for our salvation.

"Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved." Acts 4:12

ACTION POINT: Have you ever established a <u>relationship</u> with God through His Son Jesus Christ?

#### III. Part #3 -The Cup (v. 25a)

- A. The cup is a symbol of Jesus' blood. (Hebrews 9:22)
- B. The cup speaks of a new covenant that is <u>superior</u> to the old (Mosaic Exodus 24:7-8) covenant. (Hebrews 8:7-13)

"For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life ..., but with the precious blood of Christ." I Peter 1:18-19

ACTION POINT: Are you trusting in <u>Jesus' blood</u> or your own efforts to give you peace, fulfillment, and a home in heaven?

#### IV. Part #4 – <u>Our response</u> (v. 25b-26)

- A. Remember the Lord's death.
- B. Proclaim the Lord's death. (Matthew 26:30)
- C. Realize the Lord is coming again. (Revelation 22:7, 12, 20)
- D. Draw near to God. (Hebrews 10:19-25)
  - 1. By growing.
  - 2. By grasping.
  - 3. By going.
  - 4. By gathering.
  - 5. By giving.

ACTION POINT: Are you drawing closer to the Lord each day?
