HOW CAN I KNOW I AM GOING TO HEAVEN?

Step #1: Realize God loves you. "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish, but have eternal life." John 3:16

Step #2: Realize you are separated from God because of sin. "For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God." Romans 3:23

Our solution: People try to earn their way to heaven through good works, religion, morality, etc. "There is a way that seems right to a man, but in the end it leads to death." Proverbs 14:12

God's solution: A relationship with Jesus Christ who died on the Cross

and rose from the grave, paying the penalty for our sin. "...For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus." 1 Timothy 2:5, "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God – not by works, so that no one can boast." Ephesians 2:8-9

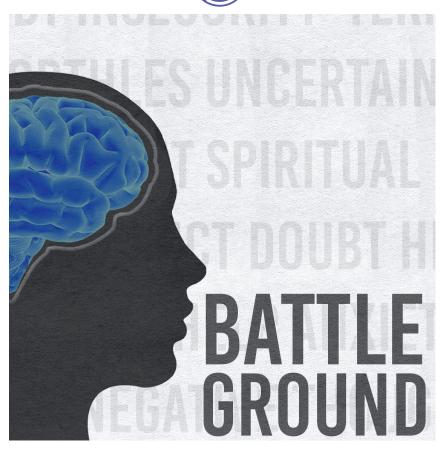

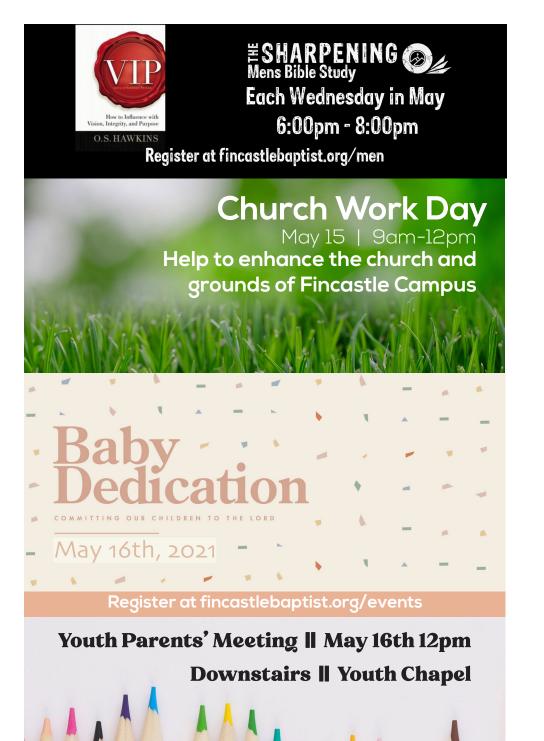

Matthew 6:25-34

I. We cannot combat worry without the proper <u>focus</u>. (6:25-30)

- A. When we worry, we turn inward
- B. When we worry, we stop believing what God has said.
- C. Why do we worry?
 - 1. Isolation
 - 2. Information Overload
 - 3. Social Media
 - 4. Expectations for Life
- D. How do we get our focus right?
 - 1. Look outside of yourself
 - 2. Be realistic
 - 3. Know your worth

4. Recognize worry as a lack of faith

II. We cannot combat worry until we live <u>differently</u>. (6:31-33)

A. Ask yourself different questions

- B. Understand who God is
 - 1. God is good (Ps. 25:8; 145:9; Mk. 10:18)
 - 2. God is in <u>control</u> (Heb. 12:2; Gen. 50:20; Col. 1:17)
 - 3. God is wise
- C. Get a different <u>ambition</u> for your life
- D. Choose <u>trust</u> over worry
 - 1. The <u>circumstances</u> may not change but your <u>perspective</u> will
 - 2. The <u>provision of God</u> doesn't come until after the <u>passionate</u> <u>pursuit</u>

III. We cannot combat worry until we are living in <u>the</u> <u>moment</u> (6:34)

- A. Shorten the time frame
- B. Trouble comes everyday but so does grace

1.) You can't change your <u>thoughts</u> until Jesus has changed your mind. (Rom. 12:2)
