I. For every promise of God, there is a <u>premise</u>.

A. We must be certain of <u>God's call</u>. (I Thessalonians 5:24; II Peter 1:3-11; I John 5:13)

B. Must choose <u>faith over fear</u>.

"For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but one of power, love, and sound judgment." II Timothy 1:7 (CSB)

- 1. Fear causes me to make excuses.

 - Sometimes we must be still. (Psalm 46:10)
 - Sometimes we must move forward because faith is a verb; it is something you do. (Philippians 3:13-14; Hebrews 6:1)

II. For every promise of God, there are still problems.

A. Problems come when we <u>doubt</u>. (James 1:6-8)

- B. Problems come when we <u>compare</u> ourselves to others. (II Corinthians 10:12)
- C. Problems come when we focus on our <u>failures</u>. (Deuteronomy 7:1)
- D. Problems come when we <u>believe</u> our doubts and <u>doubt</u> our beliefs.

III. For every promise of God, there is a choice.

- A. Between hearing and applying the promises of God
 - Obedience brings God's power, protection, presence, and prosperity.
 - God's promises are found in His Word. So, we should do three things in regard to the Scripture:
 - 1.) Talk about it. 2.) Think on it. 3.) Obey it.
- B. Between singing and standing on the promises of God.
- C. Between learning and <u>leaning</u> on the promises of God.
 - When Jesus is near you <u>lose fear</u>.

IV. For every promise of God, there is a time of waiting.

- A. Waiting is <u>not</u> doing nothing. (I Timothy 2:3)
- B. While we are waiting, God is working. (John 5:17)
 - 1. He is working on the situation.
 - 2. He is working on us.

- 1.) Are you 100% sure you have received God's call to salvation?
- 2.) If so, God will <u>never</u> leave you.
